Jacob - More fluent communication between the senior team and the committee. Can implement a correspondent between the two, for two-way communication.

Jay - Pathway from 17s to seniors, getting more juniors playing and bridging the gap into playing seniors. Getting juniors to train first and realise that they do have the skill.

Tracey - Quarterly Forecasting, fund some more social events with shorter-term planning. Canteen management/roster (especially senior representation.) Woolies/Coles delivery on a Thursday night in preparation. Freezer chest purchase?

Lana - Volunteers in place, big burnout from current volunteers. Trying to encourage more families to help out here and there - not every week. E.g. pickups and setups for 4 home games during Miniroos. Need a way to mass communicate to Miniroos parents that Committee members can assist, rather than the Facebook page getting blown up.

Andrea - Getting head managers for volunteers for miniroos age groups to assist in delegation for roles each gameday so they same people aren't doing everything each week.
